**SUBJECT:** Revision to Rule 64E-15.005, Florida Administrative Code

**INFORMATION ONLY:**

This memo is to officially inform you of a revision to Rule 64E-15.005, Florida Administrative Code (FAC) which will become effective June 7, 2007. This rule specifically relates to recreational vehicle parks which only allow self contained recreational vehicles. Recreational vehicle parks are required to have sanitary facilities, which include showers, hand washing devices, toilets and urinals, a sanitary dump station and a potable water supply station. This rule revision eliminates the requirement for the sanitary facilities, dump station and potable water supply station if the owner has a letter on file with the county health department, stating there is water and sewer hook-ups at each site and the park will only rent to self contained recreational vehicles. This rule change will eliminate costly, redundant facilities in parks that meet these requirements.

The full text of the rule is as follows:

Rule 64E-15.005(6), FAC, If a park owner files a letter with the county health department stating the recreational vehicle park has a potable water and sewer hook-up at each site and the park only rents to recreational vehicles that are self contained units, the park will be exempt from the sanitary facilities requirements in 64E-15.005(2)(4), FAC, the sewage disposal requirements in 64E-15.004(5)(6)(7), FAC, and the water requirements in 64E-15.003(3)(b), FAC.
