

PROCLAMATION

HONORING JULIANNE (RENK) PRICE

WHEREAS, in order to implement the Protocol for Assessing Community Excellence in Environmental Health (PACE EH) process in Florida, the Division of Environmental Health awarded a \$30,000 grant to Indian the Indian River County; and

WHEREAS, the County hired Environmental Specialist Julianne (Renk) Price as coordinator to conduct an environmental health assessment and public education campaign to generate needed improvements to the Wabasso community; and

WHEREAS, the return on the \$30,000 investment is estimated to be over \$1 million in public and private resources; and


WHEREAS, in cooperation with the Health and other County departments, Mrs. Price worked closely with Wabasso residents to develop a level of trust in the community in order to resolve issues such as lack of housing, safety, street lighting and access to potable water and sewer.


