Concisely summarize this month's activities.:

We continue to work with County Addressing and Fire Rescue to change some the community addresses to make it a more uniform number system. There are blocks with 2000 numbers next to 3000 numbers which can delay Emergency Rescue trying to find an address.

The last phase of the infrastructure work in the North Westgate area is still waiting on permit approvals to get started.

We are still looking into some illegal dumping problems that continue to show up in the community. All of our abandoned or buildings in disrepair have been demolished or boarded up at this time.

The Westgate Spring Festival was held on April 11th and was a great success with over a 1,000 people attending the event. Our own Lead Poisoning Prevention team was able to do some lead Blood Screening and handed out information.

The community is still waiting on the County to address the Homeless shelter and problem it presents to the neighborhood.
