The first St. Johns County PACE EH meeting with the community leaders for West Augustine was held June 30. In attendance was the health department director, Dr. Allicock, Commissioner Ken Bryan, several members from the Community Redevelopment Area (CRA), several pastors in the community, two college professors and a teacher who want to help with our PACE project.

We met with Mr. David Haynes, a science teacher for Murray Middle School who wants to motivate his students to become involved in their community. We have partnered with Mr. Haynes to educate his students about water quality and microbial water testing. The students will be taking water samples that we will be testing in our laboratory.

Mr. Ernie Driscoll is a professor at Flagler College whose students will help circulate our survey. His students are eager to help for the entire project.

We are in the process of setting up a steering committee and finalizing the members that will comprise this committee. We are in the final stages of developing our survey. The survey will be passed out among the community once Flagler College classes and public schools resume.
