

Update on PACE EH Communities in Palm Beach County

Westgate – The Westgate Community is still waiting to get the rest of the infrastructure finished in the north part of Westgate. Commissioner Koons assured everyone at the last meeting that he would find the money to finish it. He also stated that he is working to relocate the homeless people out of Westgate into a new shelter. Illegal dumping still continues to be a problem throughout the community and we are still working with the County to make all the Westgate address numbers more uniform instead of 2000 numbers mixed in with 3000 numbers. This has been a great problem when Emergency Personal were requested to respond to a call. They took some time to locate addresses and lost valuable response time. Plans are underway to organize another community cleanup. I have also talked to the community policing about getting the vehicles that are parked on sidewalks removed and requesting that people use them instead of walking in the middle of the street.



Canal Point – The Canal Point Community is looking to get some small business after the completion of their new online sewage project. The project is scheduled to be underway with completion set for September 2009. At this time they are working on getting three welcome signs put up and looking for some native trees to plant

around the community. They are also looking at putting a floating boat dock by their boat ramp on the lake.

East Lake Village, Pahokee – The residents of East Lake Village are still waiting on results from their top issues including the demolition of an abandoned home and a neighborhood park. The City of Pahokee has asked for money for the demolition of the home and I am working with someone from the Sheriff's Department and the City of Pahokee on getting the park finished.
