

Health & Environmental Terrorism Coalition Coordination Procedures

1. Someone Reports a Potential Health or Environmental Terrorism Act – should Contact Local Law Enforcement
2. Local Law Enforcement should Contact DEP Law Enforcement
3. Both Investigate the Incident
4. Local Law Enforcement/DEP Law Enforcement should Determine if FDLE or FBI should become Involved in the Investigation
5. Local Law Enforcement/DEP Law Enforcement should Determine if Emergency Operations Center (EOC) should be Notified
6. If EOC is notified, both DEP and DOH staff should be notified at both the local level and state headquarters level, including the DEP and DOH Lab staff, and the Communications staff
7. The DEP and DOH Laboratory staff should determine:
 - What should be tested for in the field?
 - Who should sample?
 - For what?
 - Ensure that proper sampling techniques are used, and sample volumes taken.
 - Which lab should analyze for which parameters?
